Notes on the Social Sailing group meeting on 31st March 2017

34 Members of the group attended the meeting, 12 people apologised. (Paul Young, Ainsworths, Aitkens, Jan Wareham, Gledhills, Pat Bovis, Caves, Bakers, Mike Wright-Anderson and Pam & Peter Chrismas)

SUBS: Mike Tong, Fleet Captain, reminded everyone that subs were due at the A.G.M. and anyone who has not paid can see June after the meeting. Paul Young, the Treasurer, was unable to attend today.

<u>CRUISER MEETING REPORT:</u> David Dodgson, Rear Commodore Cruising gave the following report:

Pontoon: It is hoped the appointed contractor can carry out the work at the end of June/beginning of July, but planning consent is still awaited. **Toni Durrant** enquired about the cost but the figure is not known. Fund-raising is progressing well, and with a substantial amount raised from a dinner and auction and duty waivers. There were two proposals 1) three mtrs wide to allow for tenders, and 2) one and a half mtrs wide which costs less and creates less problems. An artist's impression was passed around showing a raised walkway and a drop down to the hammerhead. This will be 10 metres further out than before, and, therefore, usable at low water.

Ferry: The new Selene is having work done to correct the major fault that affected last year badly, the hydraulics have been removed and an electric winch installed. It should be ready for the end of next week. Ferry times will be on the website, but a list was available for viewing. The mooring list will follow soon.

Outboard Shed: Problems occurred last year, mostly with fuel being stored in the shed. This must not happen as it would invalidate the Club's insurance, also engines must not be left on trolleys, but housed correctly on shelves. New keys are available at a cost of £10.00 and tags will be given for attachment to the engines. The lock will be changed on Monday (3rd April). Access to the fuel shed has posed problems, but this is the responsibility of the Marine Dept. **Mike Tong** will speak to Mitch about this.

Work Party: Finally, **David** thanked all who helped with the work party, which was very successful.
